Ticket Sales for Spring for Dance

Ticket presales will begin during staging rehearsals in the theater lobby on Tuesday, April 1st from 4:30-5:15 p.m. (for Advanced Dance families), on Wednesday, April 2nd from 4:30-5:15 p.m. (for Intermediate Dance families), and on Friday, April 4th from 4:30-5:15 p.m. (for Beginning II Dance families). Please bring cash or check payable to NUHS Theatrical Dance. Tickets are \$10, \$12, and \$15, depending on seating location. All seating is reserved. Public sales will begin online at our website, www.nevadauniondance.com, beginning Saturday, April 5th. Tickets will also be sold in the theater lobby from 4:00-6:00 p.m. during our dress rehearsals on April 22nd-24th and April 30th and May 1st. Tickets may also be purchased at the box office on performance nights from 5:30-7:00 p.m. Students can purchase tickets in the cafeteria during lunch on April 22nd-May 2nd. <u>Countdown to Spring for Dance</u>! Mandatory Classes and Rehearsals

We are so excited to be in the final weeks before opening night of *Spring for Dance 2014*. The dancers have been preparing all year for this production, and the art department and set design classes have been working hard to complete the sets and artwork that will complement each piece in this show. A schedule of tech and dress rehearsals is attached to this newsletter and available on our online calendar. Dancers must arrive 15 minutes prior to their scheduled technical rehearsal(s) to warm-up. Dress rehearsals will be run exactly as a performance, so dancers need to be in full costume and makeup.

A detailed list of costume requirements is also attached to this newsletter. Please don't delay in ordering needed supplies (e.g. extra pairs of tights, dance shoes, costumes or accessories that you need to provide), to ensure that you have everything needed prior to tech rehearsals.

It is very important for all dancers to be present in class and rehearsal during the weeks of our staging, tech, dress rehearsals and performances because their bodies need consistent training and stamina for performance, and because staging and choreography notes will be reviewed daily in classes and rehearsals. Unexcused absence from class or mandatory rehearsals may result in being staged out of the show. If there is a necessary reason to be excused from class or a mandatory rehearsal, please contact Mrs. Wadman as soon as possible.

Production Volunteers Needed

We will need parents to chaperone each of our dressing rooms (beginning, intermediate, and advanced), run ticket sales or take tickets at the door, supervise flower sales or refreshment sales in the lobby, and provide security outside the theater. Tech & Rehearsal Schedule Spring for Dance 2014

<u>Performers:</u> You must arrive at least 15 minutes before your scheduled rehearsal to warm-up and be ready to go! Dancers must be prepared and dressed in nude-colored leotards and tights (undergarments) as well as costumes for all tech and dress rehearsals. Stage makeup (foundation/powder, blush, eyeshadow, eyeliner and mascara, and <u>red</u> lipstick) needed for photo shoot, dress rehearsals, and performances (not needed for tech).
